We advise that you include information relating to the following points when communicating with us about your requirements:

- o Which language(s) do you require?
- Would you prefer your interpreter to be: male, female, or do you have no preference?
 (This may be a relevant consideration in relation to sensitive subject matter and particular cultural contexts.)
- O What is the date of the assignment and how long will it last?
- o Where is the court? (Please provide the full address.)
- o Do you have the court number?
- o Are there parking facilities?
- o What is the nearest underground or railway station?
- o At what time should the interpreter arrive for briefing?
- o Who should the interpreter ask for when they arrive?
- o Who will the interpreter be interpreting for?
- Who is responsible for payment of our invoice?
 (Please note that our credit terms are 15 days)
- What is the subject matter of the case? (We would appreciate further information about the case and copies of any documents that could help the interpreter prepare for the assignment. All information will be treated confidentially.)
